Update on the Possible Closure of the Consulate General of Switzerland in Chicago

In the spring of 2012, the SABC was informed of the decision that the Consulate General of Switzerland in Chicago was to be closed by mid 2014 due to budget cuts. The SABC, in turn, took on a proactive effort to fight this decision. All our letters, and responses are available on our web site by clicking <u>HERE</u>.

On April 16th the motion was presented to the full National Council who voted 153 to 22 to keep the Consulate General of Switzerland in Chicago open. This was a great success and we can be very proud of our efforts and those of our partners who also voiced their opposition.

However, on May 13, the Foreign Relations Committee of the Council of States voted 5 to 3 in favor of the closure. This is a slight set back but the motion will be put in front of the entire Council of States on June 6th for vote.

We, the SABC, are working with our local partners as well as our network in Switzerland to form a final effort to inform the stakeholders of our opposition to the closure and to show our passion for the issue. Jan. 16, 2013 - The SABC co-sponsored an event by the International Trade Association discussing the Global Trade Outlook 2013: Implications for an American Manufacturing Renaissance.
