Nearly one year into the Trump Administration, there remains tremendous uncertainty about the future of U.S. trade policy around the world. From NAFTA to the U.S.'s many other multi-lateral and bi-lateral trade relationships, the future of U.S. trade policy and leadership is in doubt. Now, on the eve of the Sixth Round of NAFTA Negotiations (January 23-28 in Montreal), seems to be an appropriate time to take a deep breath and look ahead at the future of global trade for 2018.



Derek Gianino is Director of International Policy at the U.S. Chamber of Commerce.
